ORIENTATION

You can find answers to any questions at the central information points and from our information team. Signs will guide you through the BUGA, to the entrances, exits, and parking.

TOURS

You are welcome to join one of our public tours (limited availability - meet at Innenstadt entrance on the site map, 9.00 € per person) of the BUGA grounds. Public tours are held every day at 11am, with additional tours at 2pm on weekends and public holidays. ACCESSIBILITY

Almost every area of the exhibition grounds is accessible for people with impairments. Parking, information points, toilets, and gastronomy are all accessible. More information is available in our special information leaflet on inclusion.

EXPERIMENTA – THE SCIENCE CENTRE

A unique world of knowledge and experience stretching over 25,000 square meters offers around 275 interactive exhibitions, four creative studios, and nine laboratories to our visitors, as well as an observatory and an extraordinary science dome with spectacular science shows. Welcome to the new experimenta, directly adjacent to the BUGA Heilbronn 2019.

MOBILITY ASSISTANCE
